



TESA December 2014 Newsletter—Highlights of December 2014 Board Meeting

The Professional Association Board Meeting (PABM) was held at the 4-H Center on Lake Brownwood December 2-3, 2014. The Texas Extension Association board meeting was held in conjunction with those of all other association groups. Following are highlights:

TESA Board Meeting:

- The **Collaboration Task Force** presented a preliminary directory of all Extension specialists, program specialists, RPLs, and other personnel qualified to be members of the association. This included all Prairie View members and qualified personnel. The intent of the directory is to perpetuate grant, programming, and other collaboration opportunities. Look for a final version in early 2015.
- The **Promotion Task Force** reviewed recommended changes to the proposed *Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service Professional Career Ladder System for Extension Program Specialists*. Additional input was provided by the TESA Board in attendance. A draft letter and a "marked" copy of the document were reviewed, will be finalized by the task force, and will be sent to Extension administration this month.
- **2015 TESA annual meeting** will be July 20-22, 2015, at T Bar M in New Braunfels. This is a family oriented resort and should be great for the kids. Mark your calendars. President-Elect DeDe Jones will begin finalizing arrangements and the program in early 2015.
- **Dr. Joe Mask** has agreed to be Chapter Director for Campus 05- Animal Science, Poultry, & Vet Medicine. He replaces Buddy Faries who retired August 31.
- We are sadden at the loss of two Life-Time members since the 2014 annual meeting—**Dr. Dale Pennington** and **Dr. Carl G. Anderson.**
- The TESA board approved the La Torretta Resort at Montgomery, TX, for the **2016 TESA annual meeting.** Mark your calendar and plan to attend; the dates are 7/11-13/16. The location and dates are pending DeDe finalizing a contract. We will let you know when arrangements are finalized.
